Winter Weather and School Closures

As we approach the winter season, we understand that there is always a possibility of inclement weather that could impact the school's ability to open safely. While we strive to keep the school open whenever possible, the safety of our children and staff remains our top priority.

When making the decision to open or close the school, we carefully consider various factors, including:

- Weather forecasts: We closely monitor weather forecasts from reputable sources to assess the severity and timing of any potential weather events.
- Local road conditions: We evaluate the condition of local roads to ensure safe passage for students, staff, and bus drivers.
- Staff travel distances: We consider the distance that our staff members travel to and from school, ensuring that they can safely commute in adverse weather conditions.

We recognise the disruption that school closures can cause to families' schedules and the potential impact on students' education. However, if we determine that school closure is necessary, we will promptly inform parents via email, text message, and our school's Facebook page. We will strive to make this decision as early as possible to allow families ample time to make arrangements.
