

Wraparound Care and School Club Payments

Effective from after the Easter break, there will be some changes to the payment process for wraparound care at Newtown.

Our school administration have been facing ongoing difficulties in collecting payments for school clubs when not booked on the School Money system or booked in person on an ad hoc basis. This is resulting in significant time and effort dedicated to seeking and receiving payment from parents to avoid significant arrears. Therefore, going forwards, all club places at Newtown will need to be paid for either on the School Money app or when a booking is made; we are able to take card payments over the phone or in person. Places can only be reserved once payment has been received by the school.

Due to staffing ratios, we do have a limited number of places which will be reserved on a first come first served basis, however, we will always do our best to accommodate late bookings as we understand that sometimes arrangements can change. Payments must be made at the time of booking.

I understand this may cause some inconvenience, but it is necessary to reduce alleviate the administrative burden being faced.

Should you require assistance or if you have any concerns regarding this change, please do not hesitate to contact our administration team. We will be more than willing to assist you in clarifying any queries or resolving any issues you may have.

Boiled Egg Competition Reminder




