There are lots of exciting developments in the pipeline which we look forward to sharing in due course. Next on the agenda... new PE kits as we look to raise standards and expectations for all.


Staffing Update

Shropshire Council is preparing to become a cashless council. The intention is to make the switch to being 'cashless' on 1 April 2023, when the council will no longer accept payments for services in cash.
