#### **New Hedging**

You may have noticed that there has been a new hedge line that has been planted alongside the path which was installed last year. This has been planted by the school as part of a re-landscaping project which will take place over the coming months. Having had the hedging for more than 12 months, it needed to be planted before the weather got too warm or dry.

The long-term view is that the way in which the school is approached from the car park could be significantly enhanced by removing the narrow walkway which currently exists between the existing hedge and the fence. Over the next few months, through re-landscaping, we hope to create a much more attractive, welcoming and communal approach to our school. The school and the Friends of Newtown will be working together to achieve this.
