Extensive Summer Works

As the school closes for the children, work will continue at school throughout the summer to further enhance the environment.

Significant amount of funds are being invested in the school to make it a dynamic, aspirational and inspirational place to come to school.

Works will take place both internally and externally.

Internally, we will be decorating and revamping EYFS, Hawk and Kestrel classrooms in addition to upgrading our kitchen facilities.

Externally, a six-lane 45m rubberised running track is to be installed in addition to the completion of fencing work and finishing of pathways to and from the car park.

This will also tie into the re-landscaping of the school approach as designed below. This will include the removal of the current fencing by the tarmac path, additional planting and seating, and an extended parent waiting area.



Ground works will be completed in the summer holidays with planting in autumn.

This is an exciting time for the school and the work that is being completed is part of the on-going drive to give the children the best possible education within an aspirational environment.


