### Wraparound Care at Newtown

As communicated before Easter, we have been reviewing the wraparound care provision at Newtown and there a few changes which are now in place to further enhance what we offer at Newtown.

#### Sunrise Club

This provision will run from 7:30am to 8:40am every morning with Mrs Hordern and Mrs Braithwaite.

Children are invited to arrive at any point from 7:30am and breakfast, for example, a selection of cereal, fruit and toast, will be served as part of the fee of £4. Please note that breakfast won't be served to children arriving after 8:20am as staff need time to wash up and clean away before the school day starts.

#### Sunset Club

This provision will be split into two sessions - from 3:15pm to 4:30pm and from 4:30pm to 5:30pm. During the first session (3:15pm to 4:30pm) we will run an after-school club like we currently do. This will be bookable on a casual basis via the School Money App and each night will have a different theme. For example, Young Engineers or Art. Children will be supported by Mr Roberts and Mrs Braithwaite in accessing these activities. Children can be collected from this at the convenience of the parent up to 4:30pm.

In addition to the above, we will also run a more specific and structured club. To ensure continuity and purpose, this club will be *bookable as a block* – usually for half a term. There will be no refunds for any weeks which are missed. Children will be separate from the after-school club and collected at 4:30pm. These clubs will be run by a specific member of staff.

From 4:30pm to 5:30pm, we will continue to offer wraparound care, and a snack and drink will be provided. Children may be collected at any point.

#### Club Numbers

Due to staffing ratios, there will be a cap on number of children per club therefore places will be allocated on a first come, first served basis, but we have increased our staffing levels, so we fully expect to be able to meet demand. If, however, you are unable to book online, it is because the club is full and legally we are unable to take additional children.

#### Cost

Despite increased costs for everything, we are really pleased to be able to freeze the cost of our wraparound care and it will remain at £4 per child per session. However, unfortunately, we will no longer be able to offer sibling discount.

#### Booking

All clubs can be booked on the School Money App. Please book and pay in advance where possible to save our admin team having to chase up payments at a later date.

If you require wraparound provision at late notice, please ring the school to book in but please be aware if our clubs are full, we will be unable to accommodate requests.

If you pay via the Tax-free Childcare Vouchers a booking form will be emailed to you in the usual way.
