We will be reinforcing the enclosure over the summer and installing an automatic coop door before welcoming new battery hens in September.

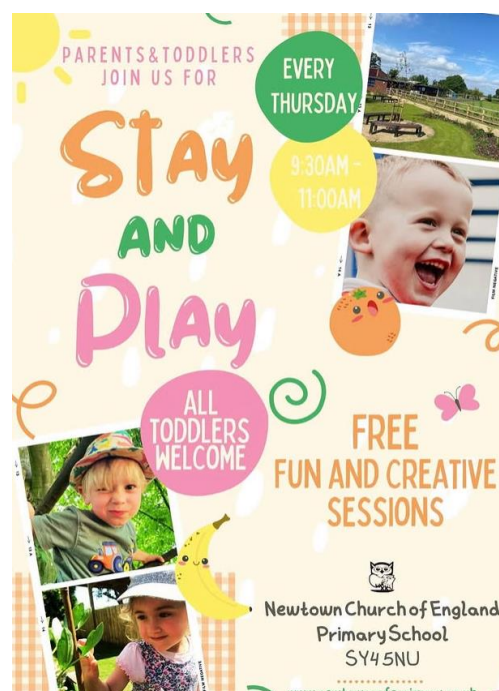
