Whilst these assessments have a level of importance for school, they also represent a key milestone in children's development.

Phonics knowledge is the foundation for all reading and is crucial to children being able to access their education as they grow older.

Times tables underpin a significant proportion of the mathematics curriculum and having a secure knowledge will make maths lessons easier for the children forever!

Well done to all the children who have completed these assessments and worked so hard in the lead up with the support of staff and parents.
